Inuvik Gas Ltd. and the Ikhil Joint Venture today announced that the repair work on one of the two gas wells located at Ikhil has concluded. Gravel and methanol supplies are being replenished and the gas well was shut in.

As announced in the December 22, 2010 Media Advisory, natural gas production from the second well at Ikhil continues to meet the demands of the Northwest Territories Power Corporation and Inuvik Gas Ltd. and its customers in the town of Inuvik.

The Ikhil Joint Venture operator, Utility Group Facilities Inc. (a subsidiary of AltaGas Ltd.) on behalf of the joint venture partners, is working with consultants to evaluate other options, or procedures to bring the well back in service.

Two wells at Ikhil, located 50 kilometres northwest of Inuvik on the Mackenzie River, supply Inuvik Gas Ltd. and the Northwest Territories Power Commission.
